Senior Week

Activity

10 am – *The Photo Booth for Seniors attending the brunch will open at 10am if you would like to begin photos early. You may take your photo in advance. Prints of each image will be available immediately after the brunch. "1" photo option ticket will be issued per student. Please decide in advance if you are opting to take an individual or group photo. If you select an individual option, your ticket will be submitted. If you decide to take a pair or group photo, everyone in the photo will submit their tickets and all parties in the photo will receive a copy of the image. The option for multiple images by the photographer will not be possible due to the timing of the brunch/rehearsal. You ARE permitted to take your own individual photos with your cameras or phones once the brunch concludes and the photographer has completed shooting.*

12:30pm- Senior Picnic @ The Fink Family Gymnasium (outdoor turf and gym area). Please wear your Class of 2018 t-shirts. If you do not have a Class of 2018 t-shirt, please wear your college t-shirt. Please wear outdoor shoes (Sandals are not suggested.) **No** shorts, leggings, or tank tops during this event. **Jeans** (non-ripped) **are** permitted due to the activities being conducted.

8:30am-1:30pm Senior Bonding (Report to Cafeteria and Outside Turf area) - Please wear comfortable shoes. – Senior Mural Painting.

12:00pm – Parents making donations or helping set up report to the Cafeteria

1:30pm-3:30pm -What Next? Project (GYM) - This is a personal send-off coordinated by the parents of Cristo Rey.

Graduation Tickets

- Each family will be given 8 graduation tickets
- Tickets must be picked up and sign for by parents
- Tickets will be distributed a week before graduation
- **Tickets will be distributed Monday, May 14 – Friday, May 18th from (9am – 4pm) If you would like a Cristo Rey graduating senior student to pick up the tickets, a detailed e-mail granting permission must be sent to IVasquez@cristoreyatlanta.org. Tickets must be “signed” for at Pick Up. Please be patient if there is a line when you arrive.**
- Instructions on picking up tickets will be emailed closer to the date.
- Ticket policy will be strictly enforced at the event

Senior Week

- All Senior Events are MANDATORY - activities and rehearsals
- Students are required to come to school the week of May 14 - May 18 at designated times
- All rehearsals are mandatory. No show, no walk at graduation

Graduation Caps and Gowns

- Cap and Gowns will be provided for our students. The school owns these gowns. Gowns will be returned the week after graduation at Mrs. Vasquez office on the second floor. Students may keep their caps.
- If students wish to purchase the graduation gown, please have your students bring \$12 on Friday May 18.
- Gowns will be distributed on Friday, May 18 at 8:30am.
- No decorated caps will be allowed at graduation.

Graduation Parking

- Parents must park at the Courtland Street Garage.
- The school will provide parking validation.
- The garage has handicapped parking and facilities.

Live Streaming

- Graduation will be Live Streamed via Facebook for those family members who cannot attend the event.
- We will not have an overflow facility.

Monday, May 21- Friday, May 25

Please consider donating “clean” uniforms to the school during this week. We will have more information when you arrive to accept the donated items. (Please be sure uniforms are either dry or dry-cleaned.)

6. Pick up Diplomas (Final Signature needed) Report to the Media Center/Library as your FINAL STOP. You will submit the Exit Form here (all signatures above must be completed prior to picking up your diploma) as you depart and receive your diploma.
